

MiSHCA Summary Points

- ▶ **Michigan School Health Coordinators Association (MiSHCA):** A network of school health coordinators who work throughout the state to encourage school leaders to provide evidence-based prevention programming to students.
- ▶ **Did you know?** Parents support *more* health education in schools.
- ▶ **Comprehensive Health Education:** Michigan's evidence-based comprehensive K-12 health education curriculum is the *Michigan Model for Health*. The MMH is listed on the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration's (SAMHSA) National Registry for Evidence-based Programs and Practices (NREPP).
- ▶ **Return on Investment:** For every dollar invested by the Michigan legislature for school health education, the Regional School Health Coordinators generate nearly \$26 in additional funding—a return on investment of 2600%!
- ▶ **Did you know?** In Michigan, the only requirement for health education is a **one-half credit course** in high school. (Imagine if we taught other subjects this way!)
